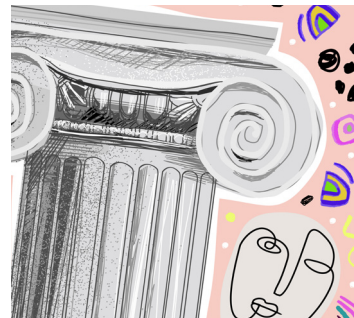

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ART

- ◆ Submissions (Paintings/Drawings) can be in any medium including crayons, watercolors or pastels.
- ◆ Due to Covid-19 pandemic our rules have changed temporarily.
- ◆ Students should produce their own artwork based on the given theme. For this year the theme is to 'Cultural Fusion'



- ◆ All paintings/drawings should be clearly marked with student's full name, age, class, city, country and nationality.
- ◆ RSI Global Art Competition will take place at all schools (Public and Private).
- ◆ Completed registration forms are required for all final entries.



To verify that this work was conducted and completed by the students themselves teachers should submit six (6) photographs of the progress of their work at different stages of progression.

Teachers should upload the evidence along with the final outcome.

Note: Each entry should be not smaller than A3 (42x29.7cm) size paper and upto A2 (42x59.4cm) size paper.

RULES FOR DIGITAL ART

- ♦ All artworks should be original and created by students
- ♦ Artwork should be in JPG format, 300 dpi, highest compression quality of 12.
- ♦ Artwork should be at least 2480px on the longest edge and not exceed 10MB.
- ♦ Artwork should not contain any frame, mat, or watermark.
- ♦ Artwork should be clear and in focus.
- ♦ You can use any app (Adobe Fresco, Photoshop, Illustrator, Procreate, Artrage, etc...)
- ♦ Artificial Intelligence (AI) images/artworks are not accepted



RULES FOR PHOTOGRAPHY

- ♦ All photography must be 30X40cm.
- ♦ Only 2 images from each participant will be accepted.
- ♦ All photos should be clearly labeled – full name, school name and telephone number of the student and the teacher.

COMPETITION GUIDELINES

- All entries need to be digitally submitted via the link.
- RSI GLOBAL ART COMPETITION is open only to students who have been entered by a teacher or programme manager in any public or private schools or organizations around the world. It is not the responsibility of RSI ART AWARD to obtain parental consent where the student's artwork is registered by a programme manager or teacher. If a teacher or programme manager is registering a student's work, it will be assumed that any necessary parental consent has first been obtained by them.
- Submitted artwork must be the student's original creation. Making an exact copy of any pre-existing image is not acceptable, whether visually or by tracing. Colouring in an outline printed or drawn by someone else or having someone else contribute to the artwork is also not acceptable. Artwork must not be overly derivative of images found on the Internet, in print media, or elsewhere. RSI ART AWARD will disqualify a work if they reasonably suspect that it is wholly copied from other works. Adults may give encouragement but must not have a hands-on role in creating the artwork.



- All artwork entries must be a Drawing, Painting, Photographs or Digital Art and three dimensional sculptures will not be accepted. Entries can be made from any traditional media, including pastel, oils pastel, pen, pencil, charcoal, acrylics, watercolour, mixed media, collage, or other materials, photography and digital art.
- Teachers must submit their students' artworks and agree to the terms and conditions of the Competition on our online platform.
- Clear digital copies of artworks of no more than 4MB from scans or photographs can be sent via the online account on the website by the teacher only.
- By entering RSI ART AWARD parents and teachers consent to have the children's names and their artworks to appear online and at the exhibition.
- By entering RSI ART AWARD, sponsors (parents, teachers, programme managers) of the contestant consent to the use of his/her artwork in any merchandise, advertisements, educational materials, or publicity carried out or produced by RSI ART AWARD without further notice or compensation. In turn, the contestant still retains the rights to use and publish his or her artwork.

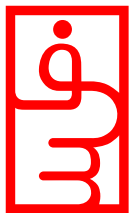
- RSI ART AWARD reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to modify, cancel or suspend this Competition or any part of it should external circumstances arise which are beyond the reasonable control of the Competition Organiser. RSI ART AWARD reserves the right to crop and/or correct artwork for display and to ensure consistency of appearance.
- This Competition will run in accordance with these Competition Rules, subject to amendment by RSI ART AWARD.
- RSI ART AWARD may reject entries that it considers inappropriate for any reason. RSI ART AWARD can publish or decline to publish, or use or decline to use, any submitted artwork at its sole discretion.
- The judge's rulings are final and without appeal in all matters related to this Competition and the awarding of the Prizes.
- RSI ART AWARD reserves the right to require a contestant to submit a copy of his/her birth certificate, parents ID or other proof of age.
- Prizes will be awarded in the categories 9-18 years of age. Prizes will be awarded for winners and Runners up. The Groupwork cannot enter in this Competition. Prizes will be awarded for individual work and not group project. Additional prizes and commendations may be given for artworks.



- Individual prizes will be chosen may include, cash, gift vouchers and other prizes. Cash prizes will be offered, and ID of parents will be requested to validate and start the process of prize giving. Competition winners will also be acknowledged on the website and through RSI ART AWARD social media. After winners have been announced Students will have 30 days to claim their prizes and will be notified by the Competition organiser of the steps and requirements. If the deadlines announced by the organisers are missed the organisers have no responsibility to provide the prizes.
- RSI ART AWARD is committed to a strict privacy policy. It will not share any personal data about entrants with any other party, without the consent of the parent, teacher, programme manager or guardian. RSI ART AWARD collects personal information for the purposes of registration, programme evaluation and to keep you informed about the competition. RSI ART AWARD may also contact you for ID, if you will be in the winners, runners up list.

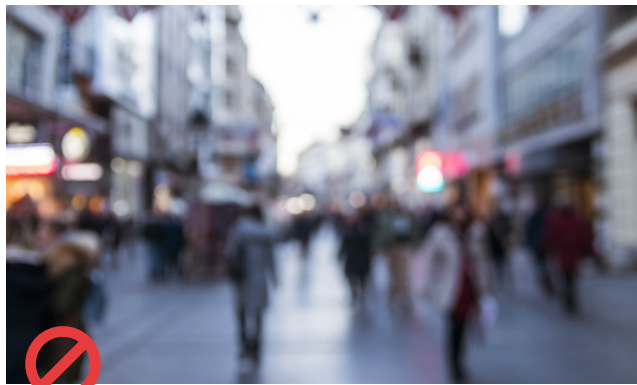

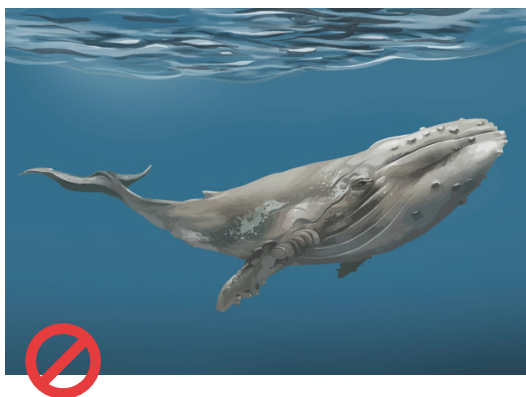

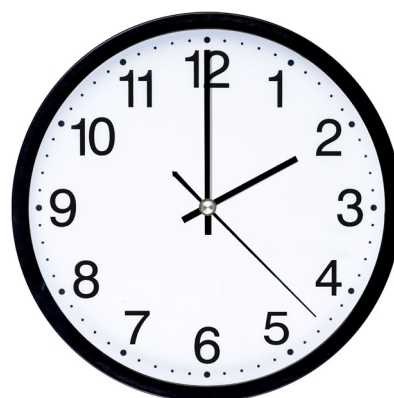
